Grading policy changes cause a large degree of confusion upon the part of the scholars and disrupts consistency.



After going through all classes, sometimes scholars don't have questions right away. It would be nice if teachers had one more session for extra help



I was informed by administration that these assignments wouldn't count against her !! What is she to do?????


