



Dear 3rd through 12th grade parents and guardians,

Official results for STAAR/EOC will not be released by the Texas Education Agency until mid to late June. The scores will be available on the [Texas Education Agency Parent Portal](#) at that time. You can use the parent portal to review your scholar's scores.

The steps to access the scores are:

- Access <https://txparentportal.emetric.net/login> and you should see the image below:

- After you have entered your Scholar's First Name, Social Security Number, and Date of Birth, it will give you their Unique Access Code and you will just need to enter the Date of Birth and click "Go."
- You should then see all the STAAR/EOC results for your scholar.
