Cedar Hill ISD Offers Universal Free Breakfast

(Cedar Hill, TX) Cedar Hill ISD is proud to provide free breakfast to all students every school day regardless of family income levels.

The goal of the program is to increase access to school meals with the hope of reducing student hunger and some of the issues that go along with it, such as low attendance or discipline problems.

“Research shows when students have a healthy breakfast they feel better, perform better, test better and behave better; it is important that our scholars start their school day with all the necessities to support their academic growth, and this is another way to ensure that,” said Kellie Spencer, CHISD deputy superintendent.

The program is provided at no additional cost to the school district. In fact, CHISD officials expect the program to generate additional revenue for the district given the likely increase in participation. This is possible because all meals served in schools are eligible for federal reimbursement. CHISD students will continue to have the option to pay a small fee for additional food and some snacks.
